Hoopla offers free digital magazines, audiobooks, music, and eBooks. All items are always available and can have multiple simultaneous checkouts, so you never have to wait for anything! (GPL cardholders only.)

## How to Use hoopla

• Sign up for a hoopla account by visiting

hoopladigital.com, or on the hoopla mobile app on your iOS or Android device. (Download the free mobile app in the App Store or the Google Play Store.) To sign up, enter your email address and library card number and PIN (from your library account), then create a password.

 You can immediately start searching for titles by tapping Search on the hoopla menu.
Or, browse titles in a specific format (Movies, Music, etc.) by tapping on that format. You can also scroll down through the hoopla Home page to browse Popular Titles in all formats!

- Once you've found what you're looking for, tap Borrow, and then Play! Titles are instantly available and you can borrow up to 6 titles per month.
- Borrowed titles will automatically be returned when your lending period is over. Lending periods vary by format.
