All you need is a device to get started!

Search the catalog

Browse the Libby catalog and borrow a title. You can search for a specific title, author, etc. using the magnifying glass icon.



Borrowing an item

Borrowing is easy! Simply find your desired title and hit the borrow button. You can then choose how long you want to have the title: 7 days, 14 days, or 21 days.

Borrowed titles appear on your Shelf (the stacked books icon) and download to the app automatically when you're connected to Wi-Fi, so you can read them when you're offline.



Managing your loans

On your Shelf, tap loans at the top of the screen. From there, you can:

- Tap **Read With...** to choose where you'd like to read the book (Kindle or Libby), then finish sending to Kindle (U.S. libraries only) or start reading in Libby.
- Tap Open In Libby, Open Magazine, or Open Audiobook to start reading or listening in the app.
- Tap **Manage Loan** to see options like Renew and Return.

Account & Settings

You can manage your account and settings using the three horizontal lines icon. You can:

- Add another library or card.
- Set notifications.
- Get help/support from Libby.
- Change Libby settings like language and add accessibility features.
